## Collage project sketchbook assignment

By this point, you should have a transparent grid layer over your collage. You are to select 2-3" square or 4 " square sections of the collage to enlarge using the viewer you have created.

On a larger sheet of paper, you will be creating 2 larger squares that will be enlargements of the smaller squares you have chosen.

The size of the larger squares is up to you, and is dependent on if you are enlarging a 3 or 4 " section of your collage.

If you are enlarging a 3 " square, your enlargement will be either a 9 " square with 3 " grid, or a 12 " square composed of 4" squares in each axis.

If you are enlarging a 4" square, your enlargement will be either an 8 " square with 2" grid, or a 12 " square composed of 4 " squares in each axis.

You will transfer the information from each square on your collage to your grid drawing.
Draw the grid lines softly so that they will blend into the final drawing.
You will have a choice to use HB or 4B pencil for this project.
