Darkroom Photography

For this project, I would like you to work with a partner, and each of you will be submitting a 3 ½" X 5" print. (You may make more if time and/or your instructor allows.)

- 1. To begin with, you will need to practice loading film into the camera. Follow along with this video which shows you how to load and unload film from your camera.
- 2. You will practice using your light meter and camera controls to attain proper exposure while shooting your test roll of film.
- 3. You will follow along with this video to learn how to develop film after you have exposed it.
- 4. You will be given an actual roll of film to shoot and develop.
- 5. You will print a contact sheet and submit a printed 3 ½"X 5" print from your negatives.
