Treasure Hunt

For this project, you will be creating a PowerPoint Presentation where you will be having your viewer go on a journey for a treasure!

Exactly what this treasure is, is up to you! It could be gold, diamonds, a person, an "A" on a report card; anything goes!

This project will have you incorporating digital photographs into your presentation.

You are allowed to take photos on a walking field trip during class time w/ Seycove cameras, or on your own time. Your presentation will have a minimum of 20 slides in total (including the hyperlinked slides), but may have more! You must incorporate the following:

- Insert a picture as background fill for the <u>title</u> slide
- You will incorporate your name, and actors names into the second slide. They must be animated (that is, use the animation feature in PPT)
- Have text over your images that hyperlinks to two or three possible choices of action that the character may choose
- You may use the same slide/picture/hyperlink more than once in your presentation
- You may hyperlink to a website if you wish, and it is appropriate
- Have Fun!!!!!

Before you begin this process, you will brainstorm on a mind map. With this mindmap, you will also present me with a simple, typewritten, overview of what your treasure hunt will encompass. It will include what your end goal is (the treasure), how many actors will be involved in this presentation, what music you will use to accompany the presentation (optional), a general idea of who the main character is, and what you will be working on over the next three classes. You will be given example of each in class

Accompanying this brief write up will be a flow chart. This will be the basis of your PowerPoint presentation. This is a very important piece of paper.

You will learn the following with this exercise:

- The use of hyperlinks
- Incorporating photos into the PPT background
- Incorporating photos into the slide, so that they may be altered
- Differentiating between the two

- Appropriate use of font size, colour, and typeface
- Logical story flow and creativity

You will hand in the following:

- PPT file (will be uploaded into my drop box titled "Adventure" you will title your file "S.ClancyBlock2", that is "first initial, last name, block number"
- Mind Map
- Flow Chart
- Typewritten overview (200 words or so)
