Audio Capture Part 2

Learning outcomes:

- 1. How to get better audio on your video recording
- 2. How to incorporate text into your Premiere Project

For this project you will be comparing the audio quality of the on camera microphone vs. a plug in mic placed on the camera. You will be recording the same scene twice; once with the built in mic, and once with a plug in mic.

I would like you to edit the two clips into one sequence. You may play the clips one after the other, or cut between the two clips. Be creative.

The clips will be shot in the same location, same lighting, etc. Only the audio should differ.

Please provide text to describe to your viewer what the audio source is they are listening to.

At the end of your video, I would like you to describe your findings (which mic you feel you would use as your "go to", and the pros and cons of each.) This could be a spoken review, or a written review at the end of your video...be creative.
