



Green Screen Project

For this project, you will be using the green screen in room 206 for Chroma keying. Chroma keying is where you will essentially be recording yourself in front of a screen of a certain colour (in this instance green) and then selecting this color and deleting it from the video layer. This will only leave the image of yourself with a transparency where the green screen once was.

You will then take this layer and place it over a still or moving image that is in the background.

While you may do this at home with your own software, you are also encouraged to create your project at school using Premiere Pro 6, or even apple iMovie.

You will be handing in a short 30 second minimum video that includes the following:

- Yourself or another actor in front of the green screen
- A background layer that is either a still image, or other video footage
- A title introducing your project (follow along with this tutorial)
