Anything & Everything Film Project

<u>Learning Outcomes:</u> At the completion of this project, it is expected that students will be able to:

- Load and unload an slr film camera
- Properly meter using an slr film camera
- Develop film and print a contact sheet
- Enlarge a negative into a positive print
- Properly focus a manual focus slr

For this project, I would like you to photograph whatever you wish. I want you to practice focusing on objects and metering correctly.

- 1. You will load, shoot, rewind, and develop your film.
- 2. You will be responsible for creating a contact sheet.
- 3. You will choose 3 negatives, and enlarge 3 prints

What you will be handing in:

You will hand in 3 prints (3.5" x 5" or larger) and a contact sheet. These will be graded on:

- sharp focus
- correct exposure
- lack of dust and scratches on print
- tight borders

You will also be handing in your negatives in their sleeves.

These will all be handed in in your envelope with your name and block on it. Please deposit these at the back of the room in the correct inbox.

This project will be marked out of 50, but will be weighted very heavily. The contact sheet, each print, and your negatives will be worth 10 marks.
