- 3. Change your aperture setting to a middle rage opening f/8, adjust your shutter so that you have proper exposure and take a picture.
- 4. Change your aperture setting to the smallest opening (highest f/stop number) f/22, adjust your shutter so that you have proper exposure and take a picture.
- 5. In your sketchbook write about what happens to each of the three photographs as you change your aperture setting.
