The Music Project

Music is essential to civilization. It helps us celebrate, sets the mood for an occasion, and is one of the most expressive forms of communication.

But what do you see when you hear certain music? What image does the song connote?

I would like you to visually represent song lyrics, an album title, or a band name (even a combination of the three).

If the music you choose does not have lyrics, how does it make you feel?

Express this feeling in images.

- I would like you to hand in 4 or more images.
- Open these in PS Elements.
- Create an 8.5X11" @ 300ppi new document in PS Elements
- Crop your images to what ever size you can to fit as many as possible on the 1 or 2 sheets of 8.5" x11"
- Save the 8.5" x 11" papers as a quality 8 or better .jpg
- Place these images in a folder with your name on it and hand in to the correct teacher drop box
- You will have one or two 8.5X11 sheets of paper, so if you would like to make many smaller prints, or two really large prints, it is up to you!

These prints will be mounted to a material of your choice (Matte board?) to be displayed in the hallway.

These prints will be affixed using the dry mount press. I will give in class demonstrations of this throughout the week.

This project will be out of 100 marks, and the marks will be based on:

- Quality of images
- Ability to place images on one larger sheet of paper for best use of space
- Presentation of the final project, mounted on Matte Board, and ready to be hung
