Developing Film

- 1. Gather the following:
 - Tank
 - 2 reels
 - Your film canister
 - Can-opener, "emergency can", and scissors (all optional)
 - Spindle for tank
 - Lid
 - Daylight Bag
 - 2. Place all of the above in the daylight bag. Put two elastics 12 inches in on each bag and slide the bag over each arm.
 - 3. Take film out of canister. If it has receded into the film canister use the extractor, or use a can-opener to open the canister.
 - 4. Shiny side up, take the film and lead it through the "ramps", or "ears" on the reels. Wind the film onto the reels using a back and forth motion.
 - 5. Place the reel with film on it onto the spindle. Place the second reel on top of that one.
 - 6. Place the aforementioned spindle in the tank, and put the lid in. **Twist** it to make sure it clicks!!!!
 - 7. Remove tank, clean out bag, and begin developing using the instructions in the developing room.
