Gallery Project

For this project you will have to create your own gallery showing. Each senior will have to fill the frames outside room 206 with their own work. You are encourage to use any or multiple techniques you have learnt this year. They will have a opening for the class, and have their work up in the hallway for about 1 week.

You will have to print your photos to the correct sizes. You need to print out

- 2, A-3 sized photos
- 2, 8.5" by 11" sized photos
- 3, 5" by 7" sized photos

You will be marked on your photos, as well as how well your photos go together. You should have a theme or technique that ties all your photos together. For example, all your photos could be landscapes. Your gallery should also show/describe who you are as a photographer. You will be marked on how professional you handle this project, your photos (technical and subjective), your write up, and how coherent your photos are.

In addition to your 7 photos, you will have to do a write up explaining your gallery show and a little bit about yourself. This you will print on photo paper as well (Size 8.5" by 11").
